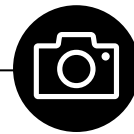

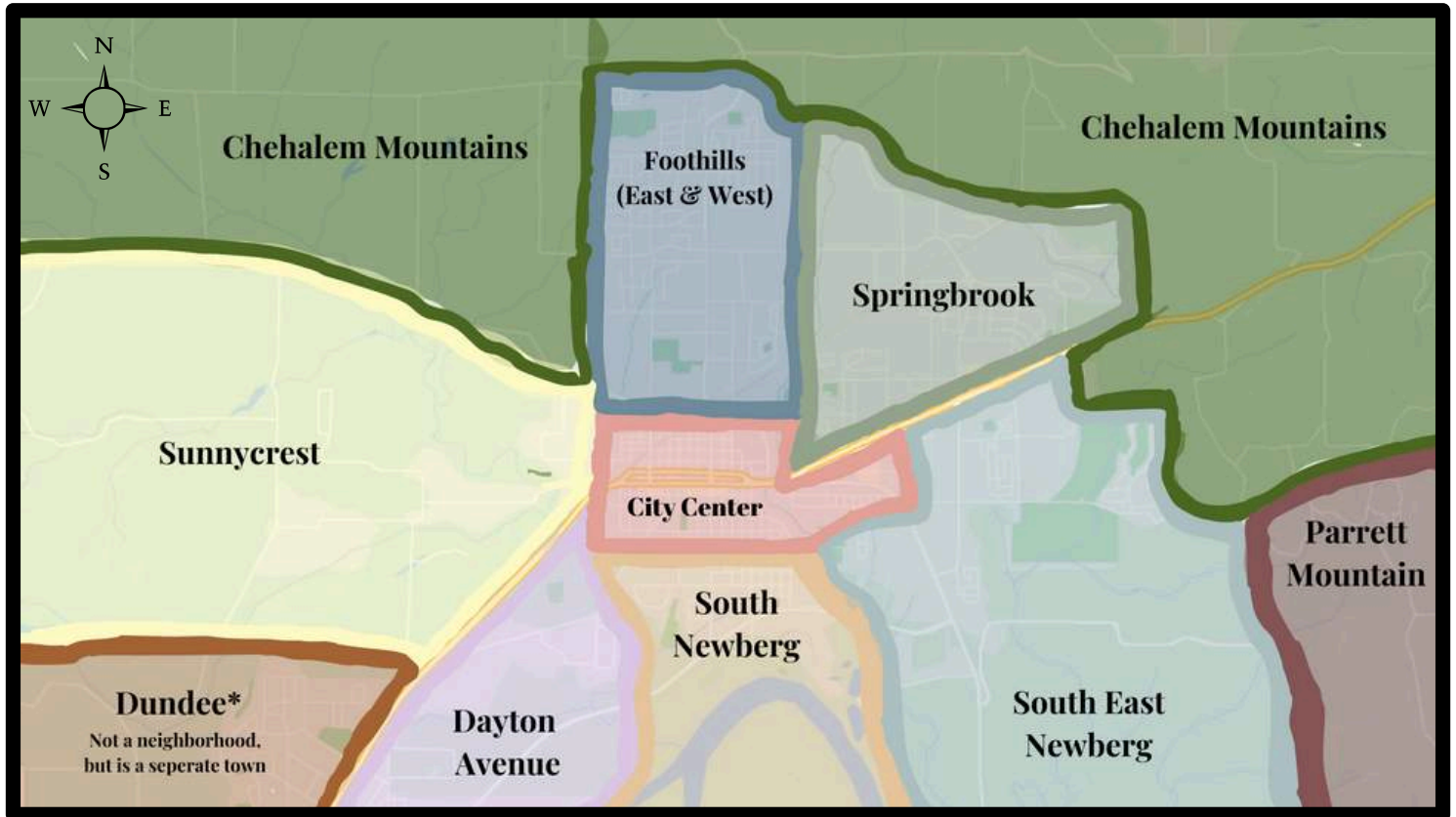

NEIGHBORHOODS

Newberg has a variety of neighborhoods for different price points. Neighborhoods range from two-bedroom homes in town all the way to large rural properties on the outer edges of Newberg. Listed below are the neighborhoods in Newberg along with a map of their locations on the following page.

These are not official neighborhood names, but are chosen to help give a frame of reference.



01

Chehalem Mountains

To the North of Newberg are the Chehalem Mountains with plenty of large properties with room for shops, livestock, gardens, and great views of the valley below!

02

Foothills (East & West)

A cluster of neighborhoods on the North side of town that has a variety of sized homes and lots. Most streets are fairly quiet and homes tend to be slightly nicer than average.

Springbrook

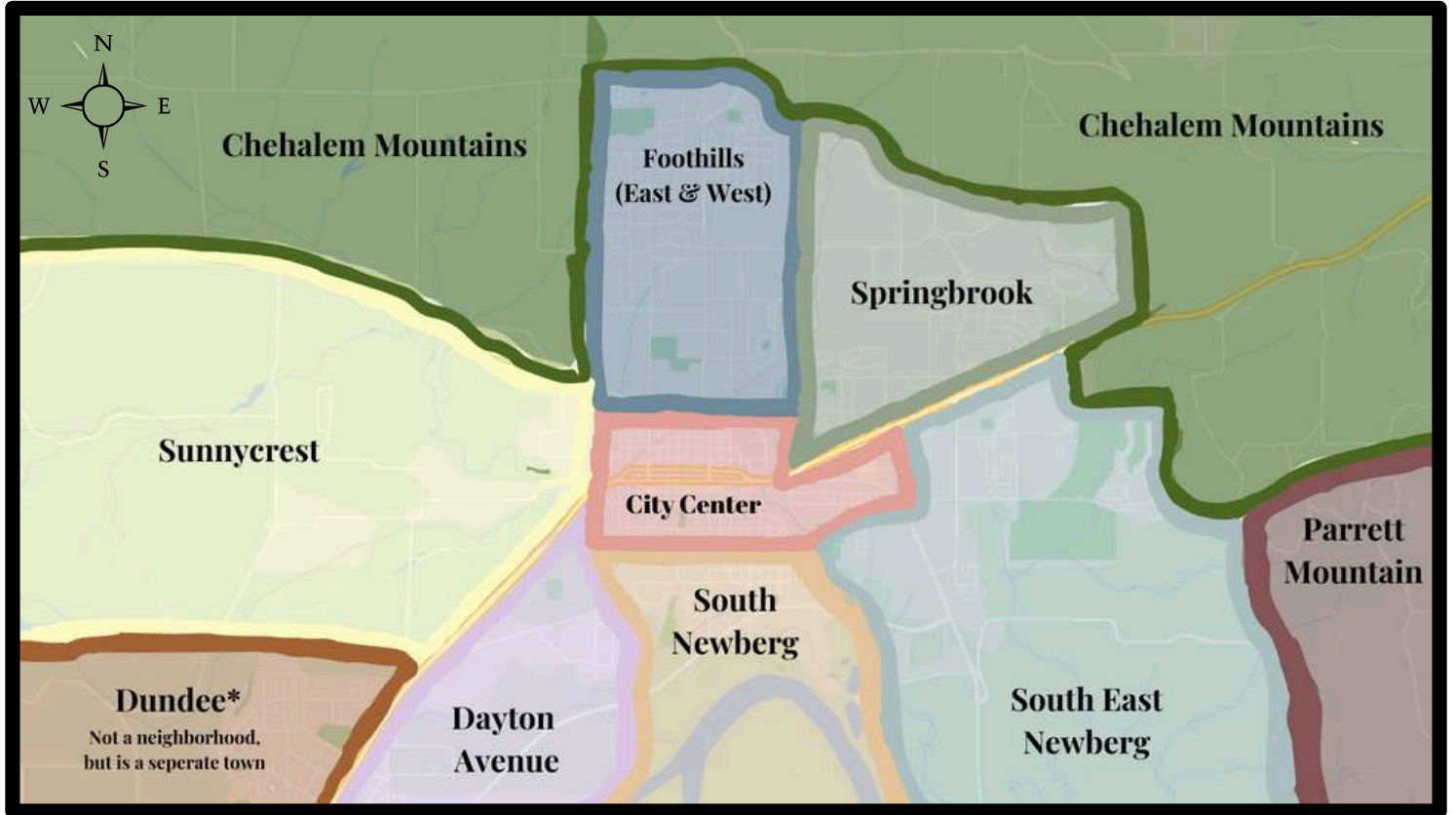
This area is close to many of the big local amenities like grocery stores and the hospital. Home sizes and lots can vary in the area.

South Newberg

One of the original neighborhoods in Newberg. It is located close to the town center and has affordable homes.

City Center

Located downtown, it is a great walkable area close to George Fox University, the library, city hall, post office, banks, and local shops.

Sunnycrest

In western part of Newberg with a low density meaning that there are more properties with a larger area of land. You get the rural feel while not being on the mountain.

Dayton Ave

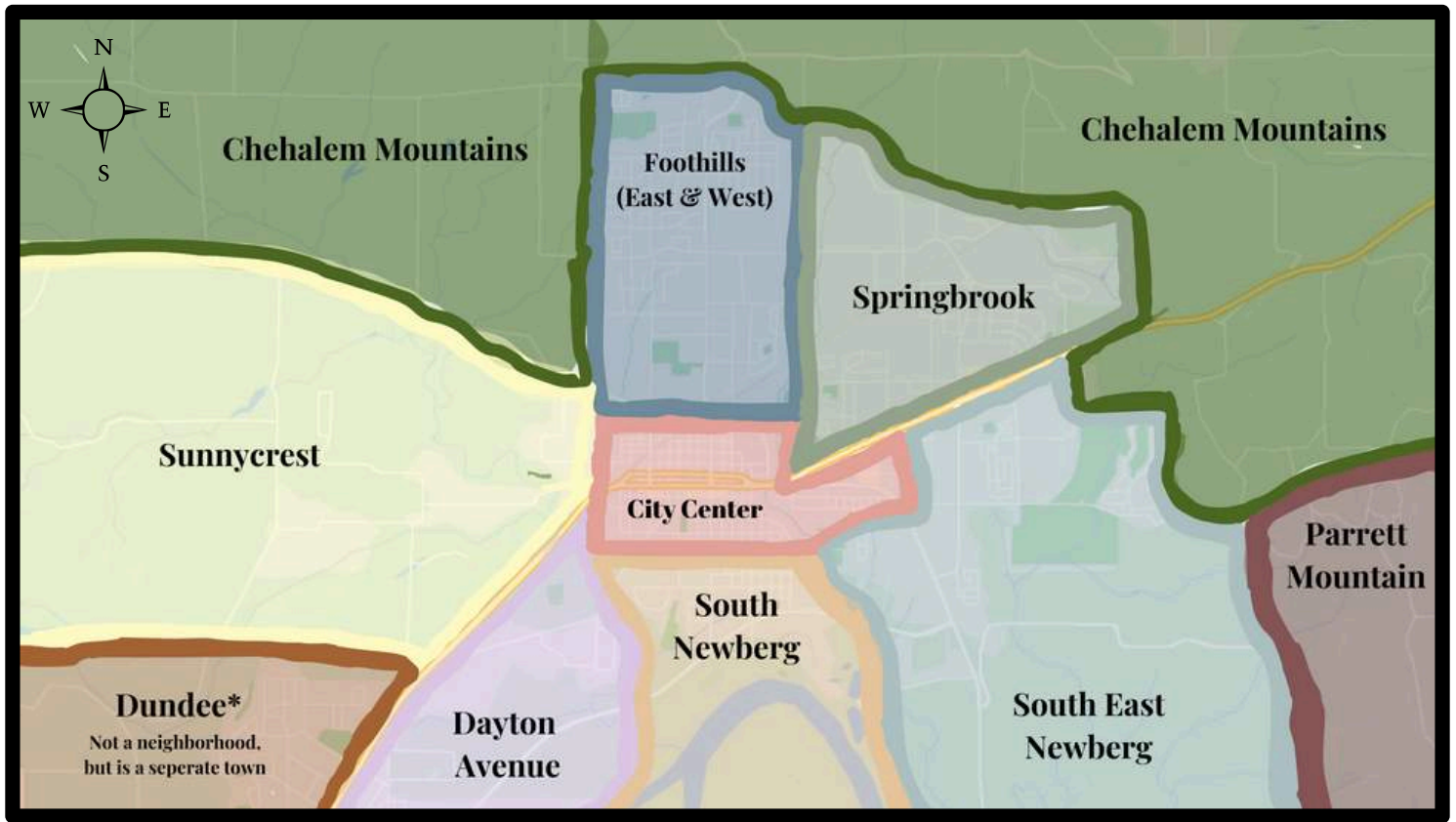
Close to town with larger homes and property sizes. Includes the stretch of Dayton Ave and Hidden Meadow where you will find small acreage lots without driving far outside of town.

South East Newberg

Has several smaller neighborhoods like “The Oaks” and “The Greens” with a variety of home sizes. Located close to industrial land and the golf course.

Parret Mountain

Located on the east side of town and is similar to Chehalem Mountain with spacious properties with a rural feel and a great view of the valley.

Dundee*

Dundee is not a neighborhood of Newberg but is a separate town. Many people who live in Dundee commute to neighboring towns, like Newberg, for work. It's a beautiful town with lots of local wineries. The northern side of Dundee is known for having nice homes with smaller lots that have incredible views of the valley.

RECREATION



Willamette River Water Sports

Kayak, paddleboard, wakeboard, ski, and fish your way through the Willamette River after launching off the easily accessible boat ramp. Daniel recently led a group in renovating the swimming shore as well.

Golfing at the Chehalem Golf Course

Surrounded by the beautiful hills of Parett Mountain, the golf course is a great place to get fresh air and enjoy the view. The course has 18 holes, a driving range, and a putting green to get your tee time in.



Nature Walks abound on local trails

The George Fox University canyon, the Friendsview Trail, and the Gettman Loop around the golf course are great Newberg Trails. Also, the Tualatin Wildlife Refuge is another trail with more length and more wildlife!

Equestrian and Hiking along Bob & Crystal Rilee Trail

This trail is open to Equestrian riders and walkers to enjoy. The trails cover a distance of over ten miles through trees and open fields.

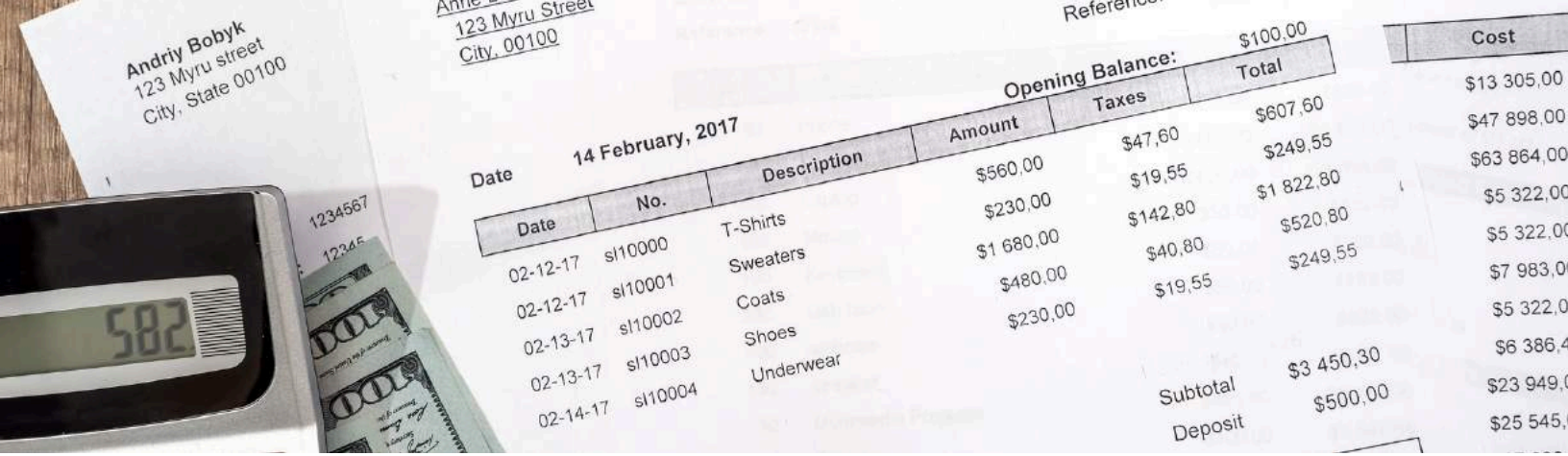

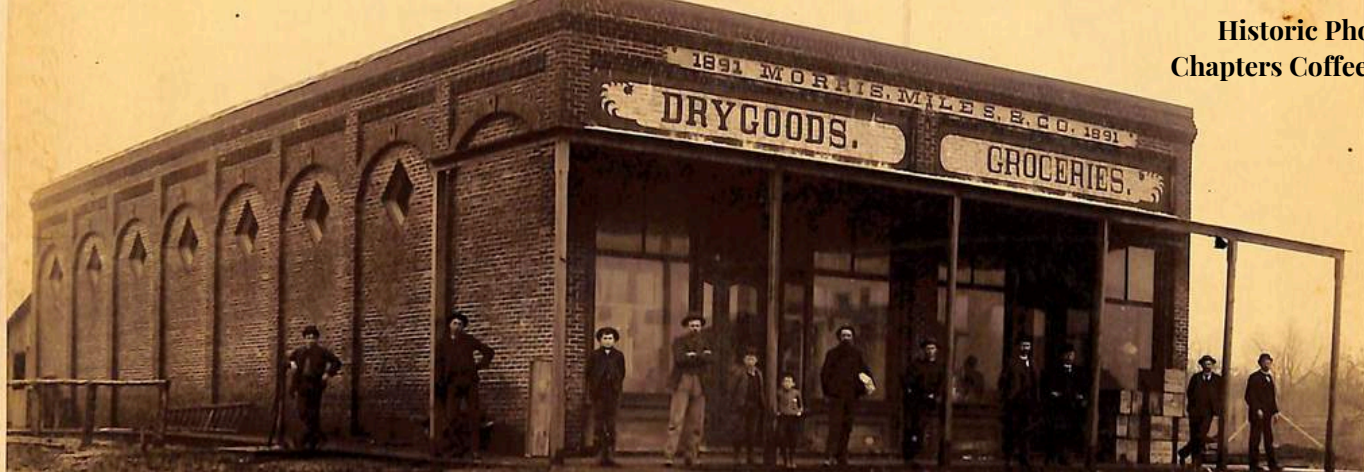

HISTORY

Newberg's documented history is rich and the town has preserved many historical places to visit. The earliest documented history begins with the indigenous hunter-gatherer Kalapuya tribes. The area was formally known as Che'halem and was eventually named Newberg after the arrival of settlers. The town grew with time and the population grew from around 200 in 1887 to around 26,000 today. The history of the town is preserved with many local historical buildings and accessible resources that can be found in the footnotes. The photo listed above is still in use as Chapters Books and Coffee. Ewing Young deserves his own link, as he played an instrumental role in Newberg's—and Oregon's—formation. A few other notable historical names and facts are listed below.



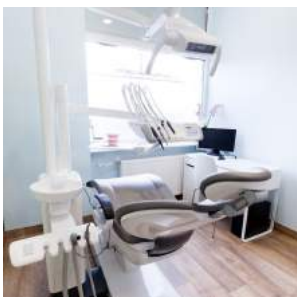
Herbet Hoover was a childhood resident

Herbert Hoover, 31st president of the United States, moved to Newberg just before his preteen years. His childhood home is now the Hoover-Mintorn House Museum. He attended George Fox University in 1885 (formerly known as Friends Pacific Academy) and has an on-campus building named in his honor.



Newberg got it's name from the town's first postman

Newberg, formally known as Chehalem, got its name in 1869. Sebastian Brutscher was Newberg's first postmaster and named it after his hometown in Bavaria.
